Establishment: UIN Saizu Purwokerto was founded in 1964 as a part of the Indonesian government's effort to improve higher Islamic education in Indonesia. Originally named IAIN Purwokerto, it focused on Islamic studies and education.



Transformation: Over the years, the institution expanded its academic offerings and infrastructure. In 2017, it was officially transformed from STAIN (Sekolah Tinggi Agama Islam) to IAIN (Institut Agama Islam Negeri). Later, it was transformed into UIN (Universitas Islam Negeri) in 2021 by the decree of the President of Indonesia (Number 41, 2021), reflecting its broadened scope and mission.



Naming: This public Islamic university was named after Prof. K.H. Saifuddin Zuhri, a prominent Islamic scholar and Minister of Religious Affairs Indonesia, to honor his contributions to Islamic education and

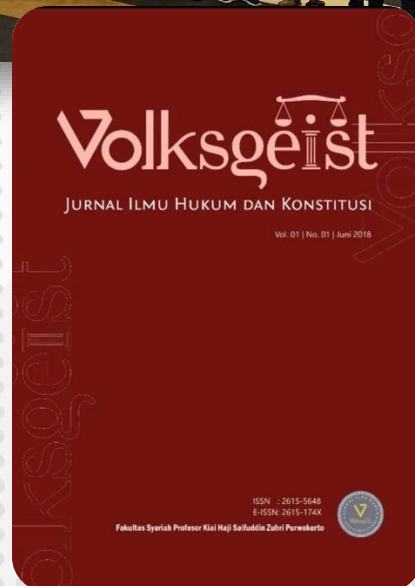
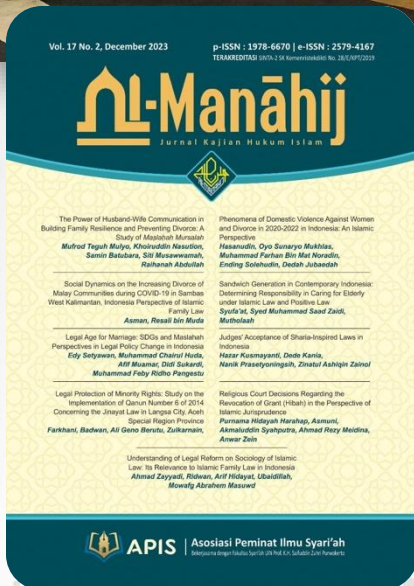

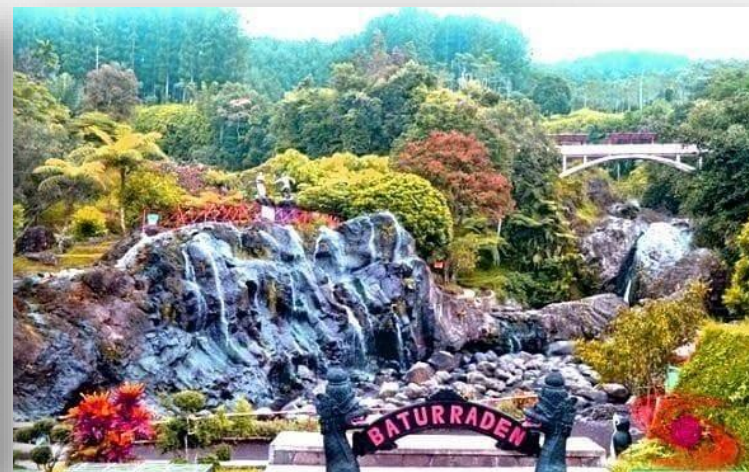
Natural Attractions

- **Baturaden:** A popular mountainous tourist area located about 15 kilometers from Purwokerto, known for its beautiful landscapes, waterfalls, hot springs, and lush greenery.
- **Pancuran Pitu:** A hot spring located within the Baturaden area, famous for its seven natural hot water spouts that are believed to have therapeutic properties.
- **Mount Slamet:** The highest volcano in Central Java, offering hiking and trekking opportunities for adventure enthusiasts. The mountain provides stunning panoramic views of the surrounding area.



Cultural and Historical Sites

- **Museum Bank Rakyat Indonesia:** A museum dedicated to the history of Indonesia's oldest bank, located in Purwokerto, showcasing historical artifacts and documents.
- **Pendopo Si Panji:** The official residence of the Regent of Banyumas, an architectural landmark that reflects traditional Javanese design and serves as a cultural hub for various local events.
